Prescription Medication Agreement

Prescription Medication Acknowledgment of Driving Impairment

While undergoing oral surgical treatment, you may be prescribed medication, such as Norco, Percocet, Valium, and others that could impair your ability to operate a motor vehicle, heavy machinery or other equipment.

Please refrain from operating a motor vehicle, riding a bike or skateboard or the like, while under the influence of the prescribed medication that impairs your judgement. You will need to arrange for proper transportation and use necessary precautions when taking prescribed medications. If you have any questions, please ask Dr. Fatehi or your pharmacist.

Oral Surgery Pain Management Agreement

After your oral surgical treatment, Dr. Fatehi may prescribe a controlled substance to help control your pain. This medication is regulated by State and/or the Federal Government. By accepting the prescription, you agree to follow Dr. Fatehi's pain management agreement. The purpose of this agreement is to prevent misunderstandings associated with certain medications and to help you and your provider comply with the laws regarding controlled pharmaceuticals.

I, the patient or guardian, understand that I have the following responsibilities:

- I am aware that there is a risk of addiction of opioid/narcotic pain medications. I have honestly informed Dr. Fatehi of the complete history of my opioid use.
- I will take the medications only at the dose, frequency and route as prescribed. I will not increase or change medications or their frequency without the approval of Dr. Fatehi.
- I understand that while I'm under the care of Dr. Fatehi, I will disclose and discuss all Opioid prescription medications that I am taking from other physicians.
- I will inform my provider of all other medications that I am taking.
- I will protect my opioid/narcotic pain prescriptions and medications. I will keep them out of the reach of children/pets and will place them in a secure location to prevent theft. I understand that lost and/or destroyed medications will not be replaced.
- I will not share, sell or trade my opioid/narcotic pain medications with anyone. I understand that this is a violation of federal and state law.

I understand that Dr. Fatehi will comply with the State of California guidelines and periodically check the DEA database to ensure compliance.

I understand that Dr. Fatehi may dispense medications to me at the office, for my post-surgical recovery. I am aware that I may elect to obtain a written prescription from him instead, so that I may acquire those same medications at a pharmacy.
